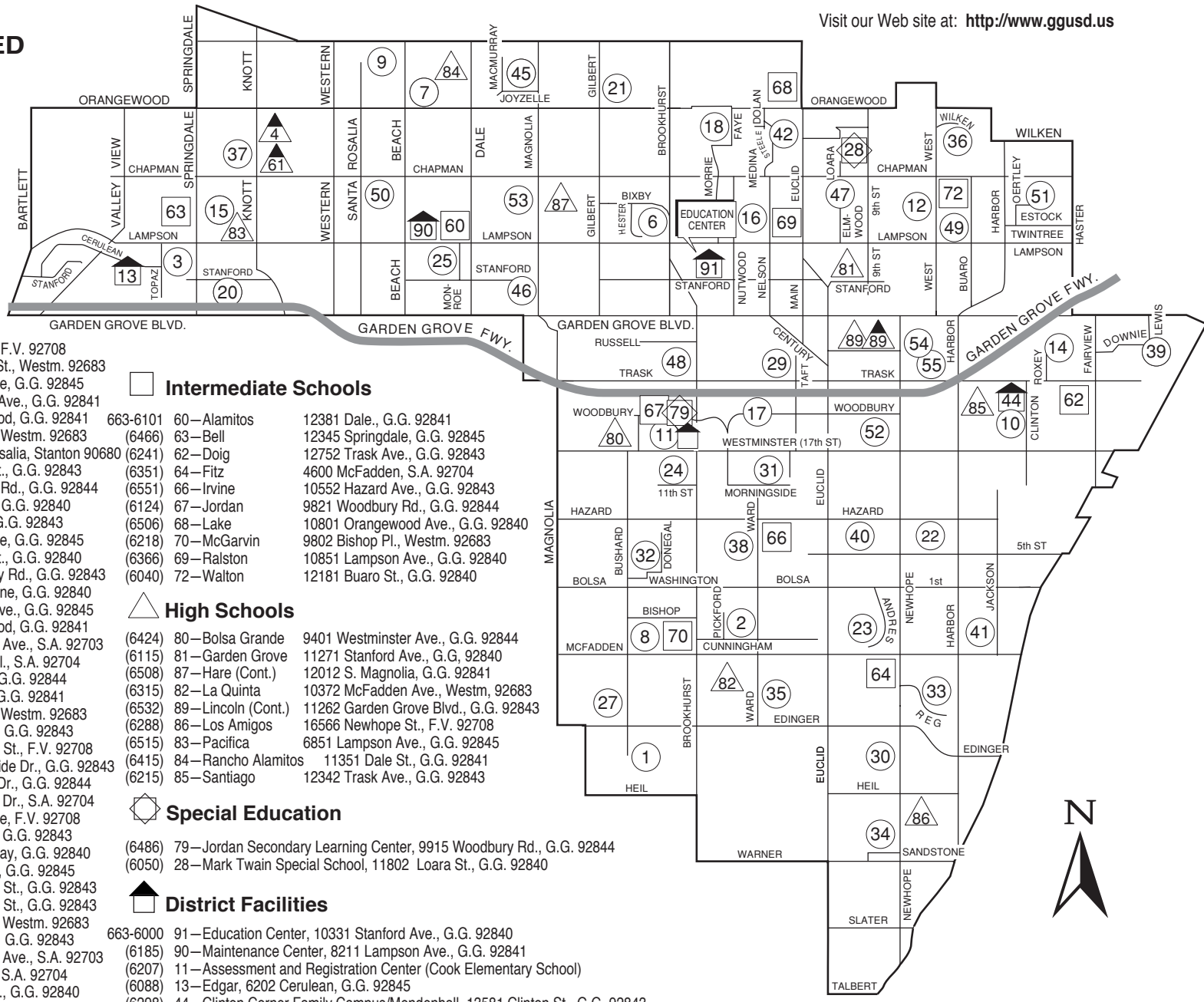

FOREWORD

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Garden Grove Unified School District was established July 1, 1965. The district encompasses 28 square miles of territory, serving Garden Grove as well as six surrounding cities—Anaheim, Cypress, Fountain Valley, Santa Ana, Stanton, and Westminster. The 2011-2012 district budget is \$487.5 million, making the district the largest enterprise in Garden Grove. GGUSD has a total of 70 schools: 47 elementary, 10 intermediate, 7 high schools, 2 continuation high schools, 2 adult education centers, and 2 special education schools.

ENROLLMENT

The 2011-12 daytime enrollment is 48,315. The daytime enrollment for 2010-11 was 48,632.
